

Notice of Race Jr Cup

Date: 5-7 July 2010

Organizing Authority: Marstrand Yacht Club (MASS), Lerum Yacht Club (LESS) and Kullavik Canoe & Racing Club (KKKK) and the Swedish Sailing Federation

Location: Marstrand

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The boats will be provided by the organizer. Class Rules do not apply.
- 1.3. ISAF Regulation 20.3.1.1 shall not apply.
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the swedish text will take precedence.

2. Conditions for participation

- 2.1. A team will consist of three persons representing the same club, that is associated with their national authority. All crew members must be born 1990 or later. The combined crew age must not exceed 50 years. A crew member's age is equal to the age of the sailor by the end of 2010.
- 2.2. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 2.3. Any club that is associated with their national authority may register up to three teams to the competition. The club shall rank the teams as Team 1-3 as instructed on www.svenskseglings.se/jrcup . The number of participating teams is limited to 64 teams.
- 2.4. To qualify to race the teams must pay a refundable deposit of 2000 SEK in conjunction with the registration. The deposit corresponds to the maximum liability, a crew must pay for an injury. If an amount is deducted from the deposit in order to cover a damage, the crew must replenish the deposit up to the original amount before it can proceed to race.

3. Entries

- 3.1. Entries are made by each club via www.svenskseglings.se/jrcup before **June 22**.
- 3.2. Entry is not valid until the fee is paid. The registration fee is 3000 SEK per team, payable to Sv. Sailing Federation no later than **June 22**.

- 3.3. Provide information for: Club, number of teams and that the payment is for "Jr Cup". Teams willing to provide the competition with a boat to be used in the races may be offered free entry. For this offer contact Christer Båth (+46705-295 906).
- 3.4. Late entry may, subject to availability, be accepted by the organizers approval until 3 July with a higher fee (4000 SEK / Team). Contact in this case jakob@ssf.se.

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1. Registration shall be made at the race office no later than 11:00 on July 5th.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. Sailing instructions will be handed out at registration.

Prize giving ceremony takes place as soon as possible after sailing.

7. Format

- 7.1. The competition will be run in heats with fleets of 6-8 boats per heat. Estimated race time is 15 minutes per race. Initially there will be a qualifying round (about 3-4 races). This is followed by final round (quarter-, semi-finals and final race).

8. Boats

- 8.1. The competition takes place in C55 boats provided by the organizing Authority.

- 8.2. Each boat has the following sails: mainsail, jib & spinnaker.

9. Race Area

- 9.1. The races will be carried out in Marstrand.

10. Course

- 10.1. Windward-Leeward course.

11. Protests and penalty

- 11.1. By way of derogation from the rules of RRS Part 5, Sections A and B, the races will be monitored directly by umpires on water and a jury in accordance with procedures specified in sailing instructions.

- 11.2. Jury decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

12. Prizes

- 12.1. Prizes will be awarded
