

Swedish Sailing Federations Safety Code

The knowledge and awareness with Swedish Sailing about safety out on the water are at a high level.

All persons that participates at activities that are within the operation of the federation are therefore bound to show good seamanship which, among other things, means:

- To follow the laws and regulations at sea
- To always use a life vest at sea, not just at competitions or training sessions
- To make sure that the boat and the safety equipment is working and follows the regulations
- As a coach, instructor or official make sure that everyone within their responsibility have suitable safety equipment, and
- To always show consideration to all that are within or close to the race- or practice area and to, when needed, assist anyone in need.

The points above are mandatory for all licensed coaches, instructors and officials at all regattas and sailing schools that are sanctioned by the Swedish Sailing Federation. Failure to follow these points can lead to rejection from the school/training or the embargoed racing area.
